Performance time

As in previous years I expect us to gather on the field in the area we have been allocated - please look out for members of the NSYO team for advice on the day itself. The event opens at 1pm and members of our team will be on site for the duration. There are food and drinks stands available, but you may also wish to bring some water.

Dress code

This is an informal concert, if you have an orchestra T-Shirts and/or hoodie please wear them but don't worry if you don't have one, just try to wear a navy/dark top instead. Jeans are permitted.
